**"AN ORDER RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (MADAC) OF THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF KITAOTAO, BUKIDNON"**

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 16 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 mandates that Local Government Units shall, within their territorial jurisdictions, promote health and safety, improve public morals, maintain peace and order preserve the comfort and convenience of the inhabitants;

**WHEREAS**, the proliferation and use of illegal drugs hamper overall efforts aimed at promoting productive Family life, community peace and harmony and ultimately nation building and national development;

**WHEREAS**, national government efforts in subduing illegal drugs should be properly Coordinated by the Local Government Units to ensure harmonious relationship into the campaign of illegal drugs;

**WHEREAS**, DILG Memorandum Circular 98-227 dated December 2, 1998 supplemented by DILG Memorandum Circular 99-016 dated June 22, 1999 sets the guidelines virtue of the Power vested upon me by law do hereby order.

### **SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF MADAC.**

The MADAC shall perform the following duties and functions:

1. Serve as focal point through which various organizations and individual work together cooperatively in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs on drug abuse prevention;
2. Provide for an effective mechanism for the coordination of existing services and programs on drug abuse prevention;
3. Provide mechanism for the coordination of existing services and programs and those which might developed in the future;
4. Perform other related duties and functions has may be assigned by the local Chief Executive.

**Section 4. MADAC- Reporting System Focal Person.** Ms. Alliah Kate F. Nala shall be designated Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council Reporting System Focal Persons.

### **Section 5. Secretariat.**

There shall be a MADAC Secretariat composed of selected personnel from the various offices of the LGU to be headed by the MADAC-RS Focal Person mentioned in Section 4 of this Executive Order. The Secretariat shall be responsible in submitting all quarterly reports to the PADAC not later the 10th day of the ensuring quarter, copy furnished the Local Peace and Order Council and DILG Field Office.




**SECTION 6. FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MADAC SECRETARIAT.**
